General

To meet a long-felt need of providing educational facilities to our younger children, a school named Devasthaly Vidyapeeth, Devasthaly, Ballia has been opened. The school is located 8 Kms. away from Rasra and 25 Kms. away from Ballia on Ballia-Lucknow State Highway.

The school was started on Oct., 2, 1988. It is an English medium institution, co-educational wchich prepares students for C.B.S.E. examination. This institution aims at all round physical, mental, moral and spiritual development of the child. Special care is taken to make the child a responsible member of the society.







Educational Facilities

At present the school is running the following classes-

Subject

Though the medium of instruction in the school is English, due emphasis is laid on teaching Hindi, the National language. The curriculum of the school is the same as per C.B.S.E. norms. Every endeavor is made to provide a good foundation to the children so that they can compete confidently to gain admission in any reputed institution after finishing their studies.

Books & Stationary

Text Books, exercise books and some other items prescribed for different classes are available near by the school for easy availability.

School Uniform

A regular check up of the school uniform is done by the class teacher. The student must make it a point that his/her uniform is neat, clean and ironed daily.

Admission

- Before admission child's name has to be registered in advance. A sum of Rs.1,000/- for the candidates of LKG to IX & XI is charged as registration fee for all students.
- No admission will be granted to the student unless a transfer certificate from the previous institution is produced along with application form.
- Formal admission is completed after the persual of the application form by the Principal and the parents are informed of his decision after a test and an interview.
- Every student will have to produce a birth certificate, aadhar card and PEN Number if required.
- The identity proof like Aadhar Card or PAN Card or Voter I.D.Card or D.L. of both father & mother is also required.
- The Child must have attained the age of four years at the time of admission in L.K.G.
- If a child fails for two successive years he/she will not be allowed to continue his/her education in this institution.

Fee & Payment

As academic year begins from April so, the tuition fee will have to be paid from April itself. Except security money, no other money, if once paid will be refunded. Tuition fee will be charged for twelve months. Conveyance fee will be charged according to distance for eleven months. Hostel charges are taken full for eleven months.

The school dues must be deposited regularly between 5-15th of the month, failing which the dues along with late fee Rs.5/- per day shall be deposited up to to the end of month. After one month Rs.100/- will be charged as fine for boarders and Rs.50/- for day scholars, after two months Rs.500/- for boarders and Rs.300/- for day scholars. Later, the name of student will be allowed only after re-admission with a charge of Rs.1500/- for boarder and Rs.1000/- for day scholars.

Note

All Charges are subject to be changing if the cost of commodities fluctuates. Pocket money is refundable when the child leaves the school. Deduction will be made if the child has caused any damage to the school property and if the same has not been compensated by him. Other dues also payable by the child be deducted.

The parents must ensure that their wards are free from disease specially contagious, when they are admitted in the hostel.

No body is allowed to enter the hostel premises unless permitted by the Principal. After getting exit permission from the Principal, parents can take their children out on <u>second Saturday or Sunday</u>, only once in a month. The students will be taken out only after the school hours and be brought back to the hostel on <u>Sunday by 6 p.m.</u> Children can be taken out for long holidays also only by the Parents/Guardians or the people authorised by them in writing will take the children out. <u>In no case the children will be handed over to any other person.</u>

The practice of meeting the children frequently is not helpful to them, so the parents must see them only once a month i.e., 2nd Saturday or Sunday.

Medical Care

Though the school takes all normal precautions, it does not take any responsibility for accidents.

Valuable

Parents/Guardians are advised not to give valuable articles like watches, cameras, rings, cell phones electronics gadgets, jwellery etc. to their wards when they come to the school. The school does not takes any responsibility for the loss of such valuables.

Medical Facilities

A registered medical practitioner is available and all necessary medicines for general sickness are kept in the school M.I.Room. For serious disease the children are taken to Rasra, Ballia or to any other competent Doctor. Time to time vaccination and visit of specialist Doctors like eye specialist, dental specialist etc takes place.

Health Care

Personal hygiene of the children is frequently inspected. Height and weight of the children are recorded after every quarter. Necessary action is taken if there is any deterioration in their health. It has been decided to build one infirmary which will be managed by a trained nurse.





Breach of discipline

A transfer Certificate is issued only after all dues have been paid. In case if boarders leave the school, they must collect their luggage and goods from the hostel within 15 days of their departure. After that the school will not be able to safeguard it.

Persons Entitled To See The Boarders

Full co-operation of the parents and guardians is sought to make the children disciplined with a sound character. Punishment will be given to the children for any breach of discipline. Serious case of indiscipline may cause expulsion also.

Administrative Arrangement At Entrace

Only Parents/Guardians and other nominated persons at the time of admission can see their wards. As a rule the visitors mentioned above can see their wards between 9.00A.M. To 8.00P.M. On second Saturday or Sunday of the month. Entry for the work in office or elsewhere will be admissible only after getting the signed consent of a concerned authority and the visitor will sign the Visitor's Book for all purposes other than the work in office. The meeting place will be the reception only.

Guest Room

If the gate keeper allows the visitor to enter in the gate, he/she can see a boarder only after getting the consent of the authorities. There is an arrangement to see the boarder in the reception room. The visitor will meet the desired student in the reception room where he/she is called.

People coming from distant places may need stay at night as a paying guest. Arrangement will be made in the guest room for their stay on very nominal charges.

Note:-

Incase of above all if anywhere it is found that students and parents do not follow the rules, it will be treated as an act of indiscipline.

Religious And Moral Education

Our Institution is of secular character but children are educated about the teaching of all great religions. The importance of all festivals is explained to them in morning assembly everyday. Care is taken to involve children in all these activities.

Games, Sports, Physical Training & Computer Training

Children are trained for mass PT, Yoga & arrangement is there for all major Games (Kabaddi, Volleyball, Football, Hockey, Handball, Cricket, Athletics, Throwing events, Indoor Games etc. The school possesses a children's Park for L.K.G. & U.K.G. Classes. Internet facility along with computer is available to provide latest information to the students.

With<u>drawals</u>

Parents/Guardians who wish to withdraw their wards at the end of the term, have to give a notice at least one months prior to the commencement of the next term, failing which they will have to pay the full fee for the ensuing term. Students withdrawn during the middle of a term, will have to pay the fee for the whole academic session.

Educational Tour

Grown up children will be taken for educational tour to various important places on their own expenses. Small children will be taken out for picnic to the beauty spots not very far from the school.









Hostel

At the entrance of every hostel, there will be a gatekeeper who will lead the visitor in the reception room after seeing the permission chit issued by the hostel superintendent.

As a rule the duration of the meeting will be for fifteen minutes only, after seeing the permission chit the gatekeeper will allow the exit of the visitor.

Hostel Rules & Regulation

- 1. Hostel administration will prepares an inventory for each room. All the residents should sign the completed inventory form in the presence of Hostel Administration.
- 2. In case of damages or loss of hostel property the cost will be recovered from the student of the hostel, as decided by the hostel management.
- 3. The residents shall not move any furniture/fittings from its proper allotted place.
- 4. Activities of any nature like playing loud music which may cause disturbance to the room-mates or neighbors should not be carried out in the hostel rooms.
- 5. All students are expected to be properly dressed in the hostel premises. Prescribed hostel uniform will reflect your personality and is a mark of respect to this august place of learning. Any violation will be considered as an act of indiscipline.
- 6. Residents are advised in their own interest not to keep money or other valuables in their rooms. They may deposit all such money to their warden.





Upkeep of The Hostel

- 8. Rooms are allotted to each student on his/her personal responsibility. Residents should maintain the upkeep of the allotted room, hostel and its environment. Students should not throw litter indiscriminately and should not use non-biodegradable items, such as carry bags.
- 9. The Hostel Management reserves the right to make spot checks on the hostel units and the bedrooms without prior notice to the students.
- 10. The Hostel Management reserves the right to move residents to other hostel units if there is a necessity.
- 11. Residents are not allowed to play around the balcony or inside of the room.

Visitors/Guests

1. All visitors to the hostel including the parents / guardians must make necessary in the Visitor's Book available at reception with the security guard. (Please note: guardians should register their identity with the institutional authorities during admission with the consent of the ward's parent.)

Collective Responsibilities

- 1. Residents are duly bound to report to the warden about any unwanted incident or undesirable activity going on in the hostel.
- 2. Students should not arrange any functions or meeting in the hostel or outside without specific permission of the concerned Authorities.
- 3. Any case of theft should be reported promptly to the warden.



Uses of Appliances

- 1. The use of electrical appliances such as immersion heaters, electric stoves/room heaters/electric iron are banned in any of the rooms. Such appliances, if found will be confiscated and a minimum fine of Rs.1500/- will be imposed.
- 2. The uses of audio systems like Mobile, T.V.,VCR and VCD/DVD which may cause inconvenience to other students are not allowed.

Mess Rule

- 1. Once a student joins the hostel, he/she is deemed to have become a member of the mess until he/she vacates the hostel officially.
- 2. The mess provides hygienic food.
- 3. Strict discipline should be maintained in the Dining hall.
- 4. Menu will be displayed on the notice board.
- 5. Day scholars cannot be entertained as guests in the mess.
- 6. Residents may entertain their parents as guests on a PAYMENT BASIS WITH

prior information to the Receptionist.

7. Food will not be served in the rooms and residents are not allowed to take

food to their rooms. If resident is ill, the warden will make suitable arrangements.

- 8. The quantity of food is unlimited except in the case of special items.
- 9. Residents should not enter into the kitchen.
- 10. Students should not waste food. Waste such as is not socially conscious

behaviour and is not acceptable in the institution.

11. After taking Food, diners shall leave the cup, plate, waste food etc. in the

designated bins.

12. If any diner is medically ill and requires a special diet (eg.Oil-less food) he/

she should request to the warden to arrange for this well in advance.

Important Instructions For The Guardian

- 1. The guardians have to take careful notice of the instruction to be followed at the time of admission of their wards and follow them literally.
- 2. The Guardians should strictly follow the rules regarding meeting their wards only once a month in between 9 A.M. to 6 P.M. on second Saturday or Sunday.
- 3. It is imperative that the school authority must be satisfied with the identity of the visitor who comes to meet or take the child with him or her. The parents or guardians must not get disappointed or displeased in case our decision is unfavorable.
- 4. It is essential to submit a documentary proof in support of the Date of Birth of their wards, without which the application for admission will not be entertained.
- 5. The college dues must be deposited regularly between 10th and 15th of the month, failing which the dues along with late fee Rs.5/-per day shall be deposited up to the end of the month. After one month Rs.100/- will be charged as fine for boarders and Rs.50/- for Day scholars. Later after 3 months the name of student will be struck-off from strength and the student will be allowed only after 'Re-admission' with a charge of Rs.1500/- for the Boarders and Rs.1,000/- for the Day scholars.
- 6. School fee and other dues for January, February and March must be paid by 30th January of that year.
- 7. Please teach your child the habit of punctuality in coming to school, eat right time and also teach him/her to respect teachers at school and all elders at home/hostel.
- 8. Criticism of the school or the teacher in the presence of the child should be avoided.
- 9. Parents/Guardians are not allowed to enter the class-room either to meet their wards or seek interaction with teacher without Principal and the teacher concerned through Principal.
- 10. If a Parent/Guardian feels that his/her ward in not making the desired progress, he is requested to discuss the matter with the Principal and the teacher concerned through Principal.
- 11. Guardian can contact to their wards through telephone only on Sunday in between $8.00\,\text{AM}$ to 6.00PM
- 12. Parents/Guardians can meet Principal on any working day in between 11.00AM to 2.00PM. If there is any problem to discuss about their wards.
- 13. In case the student wants to rejoin the school, he or she can do so only by paying admission fee.

The School has taken special care to provide an excellent living environment to the boarders. There are separate hostels for juniors and seniors. Each hostel has a teaching staff member as the Residential House Master and tutors attached to the house provide students with individual guidance. The house Master not only attends to the material needs of the students but also lends an understanding ear and a loving hug to them.
